Abstracts are solicited for 30-minute presentations (plus 10 minutes for discussion) that make a contribution to our understanding of the structure of the language and/or the structure of linguistic theory, including any characteristic of the morphology, phonetics, phonology, syntax, semantics, or pragmatics of Hungarian.

Anonymous, maximally two-page abstracts including examples/illustrations and references (with one-inch/2.5cm margins all around, in a font no smaller than 12pt, written in English) should be submitted as PDF files to the following address: ics11@nytud.hu in an attachment to a letter specifying the author(s) and their affiliation(s), as well as the section to which the prospective paper belongs. Papers presented at the conference are eligible for publication in the series *Approaches to Hungarian*, published by John Benjamins, Amsterdam (<http://benjamins.com/#catalog/books/atoh/main>)

One person is allowed to submit maximum two abstracts: one as a sole author or co-author, and another as a co-author.

Deadline for submission of abstracts: March 20, 2013.

Authors will be notified of acceptance of their abstracts until May 1, 2013.
